Durable, non-toxic water receptacles provided and secured in a fixed position or are of a non-tip design. Critical 2 VAC 5-110-40 Animal Housing—Temperature/Ventilation All kennel buildings and enclosures protect against weather extremes. Building maintained at a temperature comfortable for each animal. Each building and enclosure Critical provides adequate ventilation for each animal. 2 VAC 5-110-40 Animal Housing—Maintenance and Sanitation Floors and walls of enclosures, buildings, and runs are of a surface material that permits proper cleaning and disinfecting. Each kennel building and enclosure is clean, dry, and Critical sanitary. 2 VAC 5-110-40 Animal Housing--Suitability Animals are maintained in guarters that prevent escape, protect them from injury, and safeguard them from being stolen. Provisions are made for the separation of animals Critical according to species, sex, age, and temperament. 2 VAC 5-110-50 Cage Construction Cages are constructed of stainless steel, fiberglass, heavy galvanized metal, galvanized Critical $\Box$ wire, or equivalent. Cages have solid bottoms. 2 VAC 5-110-50 Cage Size Enclosures are constructed and maintained to provide sufficient space for each animal to turn freely, and easily stand, sit, and lie in a comfortable position. Critical $\Box$ 2 VAC 5-110-60 Sanitation Process There are faucet and hose connections at convenient locations for washing and cleaning the animal housing areas. Disinfectants or germicidal agents are used to clean the Critical $\Box$ housing/confinement area. 2 VAC 5-110-70 Food Preparation Food preparation/storage area adequately equipped. Equipment and utensils are made of easily cleanable, non-corrosive, and nontoxic materials. A sink with hot and cold Critical $\Box$ water is provided for cleaning equipment and utensils. 2 VAC 5-110-70 Food Storage Bins used to store food provide protection against insects and rodents. Food is stored on shelves or pallets a minimum of 12 inches above the floor, or in bins on rollable Critical $\Box$ castors. 2 VAC 5-110-90 Disposal Dead animals are disposed of by burial, incineration, or other approved method. Dead animals are disposed of within 24 hours, or refrigerated. Critical $\Box$ 2 VAC 5-110-100 Isolation Area There is a designated and marked isolation area for incoming animals which are ill or suspected of being ill. Ill and suspected ill animals are confined separately in this area Critical for a minimum of 48 hours before being placed in the main housing area. NSF = No Significant Findings F = Findings Critical findings are those which cause animal death, serious injury, or egregious suffering.
