Dear WATERMAN,

You have been selected as eligible for a Commercial Electrofishing License for HARVEST AREA. Prior to receiving your license, Chapter 4VAC20-1360-10 et seq "Pertaining to Commercial Electrofishing" requires you to demonstrate to the VMRC completion of an approved electrofishing operation safety training course and produce your electrofishing gear for inspection by VMRC or VIMS staff. Any approved electrofishing gear must be capped at allowing a maximum frequency of 15 Hertz. A training course will be offered by VMRC and VIMS in the spring of 2020 or you may locate another electrofishing course of which VMRC or VIMS staff approves.

As per Chapter 4VAC20-1360-30 Subsection D, any individual selected for Commercial Electrofishing License eligibility who fails to return this form completed, accepting or rejecting selection within 14 days of selection shall forfeit their eligibility for the current calendar year and another individual shall be selected.

All regulations and prohibitions pertaining to commercial electrofishing may be found in Chapter 4VAC20-1360-10 et seq "Pertaining to Commercial Electrofishing".

I, WATERMAN, accept selection for a Commercial Electrofishing License in HARVEST AREA and I understand I must fulfill the course completion and gear inspection requirements prior to receiving my license.

I, WATERMAN, forfeit selection for a Commercial Electrofishing License in HARVEST AREA. I understand that I forfeit my eligibility for the current calendar year and that another individual shall be selected for such license.
