Great News! You may now be eligible for health coverage.

Virginia’s Medicaid program is changing! Most adults who are 19 to 64 years old who get SNAP will be able to get Medicaid by January 1st – and there is a simple way to sign up. You get SNAP, so you just have to answer a few questions. You answer these questions by:

Calling us [days and hours they can call] and answer the questions over the phone [Cover Va & Enterprise number]; **OR**

Answer the questions online through your account on CommonHelp [web address]; **OR**

Answer the questions below and mail this form in the enclosed return envelope.

You must answer these questions if you call, apply online or mail this form back to us:

1. Do you need help with everyday things like bathing, dressing, eating, walking or using the bathroom to live safely in your home? OR Has a doctor or nurse told you that you have a physical disability or long term disease, mental or emotional illness, or addiction problem? Yes No

2. Do you have income that was not counted or has changed since your SNAP determination? Yes No

3. You do not need to file taxes to receive Medicaid. However, if you do plan to file a tax return, does anyone on your tax form live outside your home? Yes No

We will let you know whether we are able to enroll you in medical coverage starting January 1, 2019 using this information. If we find that we need more information, you may need to file a full Medicaid application and we will tell you how to do that if necessary. If you lose SNAP before January 1, you will need to submit a new application. You have to be active in SNAP to be enrolled under this strategy.
