

**Virginia Breeders Fund Application for Registration of a Virginia Thoroughbred Stallion**  
 All applications must be complete and accompanied by the appropriate registration fee or they will be returned.

**Fee Schedule**

<b>Annual Registration:</b> By January 31 of the year standing in Virginia or within 30 days of entry into Virginia.	\$100.00	\$200.00
<b>Annual Late Registration:</b> After February 1 but before August 31 of the year standing in Virginia.	\$250.00	\$350.00

- Stallions must be registered ANNUALLY with the Virginia Breeders Fund
- To be eligible for awards from the Virginia Breeders Fund, a stallion owner/lessee must submit this application to the Virginia Thoroughbred Association prior to the commencement of the breeding season of the year in which the stallion will be siring Virginia-bred horses or within thirty (30) days of the stallion's entry into stud in the Commonwealth of Virginia if such entry is after the breeding season commences.
- **A notarized copy of the stallion's Jockey Club Registration papers**, clearly showing the front and transfer side of the document, must accompany this application.
- If the stallion is held under a lease or syndicate agreement, **a copy of the lease or syndicate agreement** must accompany this application and the lease or agreement must include **a statement that the lessee or syndicate manager is authorized to sign the service certificate and to receive stallion awards.**
- At the end of the breeding season, **a copy of The Jockey Club list of mares bred** must be submitted to the Virginia Thoroughbred Association.
